BEAUTY IN THE BREAKDOWN Military Couple: Candy and James

Years of military life, deployments, and living in different states. All the pain that accompanies long distance left them wondering, how could they make their marriage work?

Shortly after they began dating, Candy moved out of state. Their relationship was forced to continue from afar. Even after getting married in 2018, their work kept the couple separated in different states – James in Kansas and Candy in Texas.

They finally moved in together and were able to enjoy life under the same roof for one whole month. Then James was sent overseas and was stationed in Korea for two years. When he returned home in 2021, they didn't know if their marriage could be salvaged.

James heard about the OXYGEN Retreat through his Chaplain and signed them up immediately. A last-ditch effort to save their marriage.

In one weekend, Candy and James were able to break down walls, engage in hard conversation, and learn practical, yet life-changing relationship skills. Not only did the OXYGEN Retreat provide hope and next steps to healing, but it shed light on areas that had been hiding in the dark for too long.

Here's a note from Candy and James to you, the community that saved their marriage and brought healing, through your support of OXYGEN Retreats and Stronger Families:

"Dear Stronger Families and those who make OXYGEN possible,

We've never been anywhere together without family, friends, or work obligations. This seminar was like a mini honeymoon for us. It allowed us to escape our daily lives, ignore our to do-lists, our responsibilities, outside distractions, and just be with each other.

Our ability to communicate, understand, listen, do things for each other, share moments, laugh, love and run errands, are all a completely new experience. I feel like my cup is finally being filled and that I'm able to help fill his cup, too. Waking up together has gone from being in different beds and barely giving good night kisses to cuddles, open honest conversations, laughter, harmony, and peace.

The OXYGEN seminar really opened our eyes, hearts, and minds to see each other for the good again and not the pains and wounds caused over the years. It helped me reflect on myself and what I need to do to improve, things I wasn't aware of that have made a huge change.

I am so grateful for the retreat and what it did for me. I've woken up from my anger, pain, and frustrations and can finally see the man I fell in love with again. There was a dark cloud over us of bad experiences and memories in our marriage. Now, we see the beauty of our love and marriage. I'm reminded of all the hopes, dreams, and awesome memories that pulled me towards him in the first place."

This retreat changed the course of our marriage and made us fall back in love again! We have never had a better relationship. After this ONE weekend. The OXYGEN retreat should be required, especially in our military community.

FULL CIRCLE GENEROSITY Dual First Responder Couple: Tiffany and Jeff

Tiffany and Jeff met while working for the Kirkland Police Department.

In 2019, Tiffany took part in one of our first ever Taste of OXYGEN trainings for First Responder Peer Support leaders. She walked away with the strong belief that "this material is what is missing for First Responder families."

In 2020, Tiffany called Stronger Families CEO, Noel Meador, to inquire about teaching a Taste of OXYGEN at an upcoming Kirkland Police family night. Little did she know, Stronger Families had also scheduled a First Responder OXYGEN retreat for Bellevue, WA and Noel invited her and Jeff to attend as a couple. They attended this donor-funded retreat and felt that the curriculum was life-changing for their relationship.

Through the investment of those that give to Stronger Families, Tiffany went from being a recipient of the OXYGEN program, to teaching it, and now has joined the team as our SF First Responder Assistant Director. Hundreds of heroes have been impacted because of this full circle generosity. Generosity that changed two heroes' lives, then a department, and now hundreds of other heroes—all funded by our tribe of leaders and community members that believe that our heroes that serve sacrifice greatly. They shouldn't lose their families as well.

"As a dual first responder couple, the relationship challenges we face are amplified. When you head out on shift, there is a responsibility to make sure you make it home every night. Being a First Responder there is real potential every shift that you might not. This weighs heavily on all First Responders but especially for our family because there is a worry for both of us. The hardest moments are when Zella (our 5-year-old daughter) asks me to stay home with her. As a first responder, we tend to spend more time with other people's families than our own. That is hard.

At the OXYGEN retreat, this was something I shared with my husband, Jeff. He wasn't aware of the fact that Zella had said this to me so often. This came out by using one of the new tools we learned in the communication section. It made all the difference. This one tool, the Coupleogue, has become an integral part of our communication.

We are so grateful for this program and Stronger Families.

After serving as counselor for a few retreats to support First Responders, attending myself, and then helping lead our team in Kirkland for the wellness block with the department, it became clear—I'm very passionate about the mission of Stronger Families. This led me to join the Stronger Families Team in 2021.

The mission of Stronger Families in not just an operational key to success for a department but a belief that is in my very soul. It has been like going to work with my other family who thinks and breaths the same goals that I have. Saving marriages and families for First Responders!

Joining the team at Stronger Families has allowed me to help strengthen other First Responders' families just like mine. This mission couldn't be more personal to me. Thank you for helping us expand and for continuing to provide support for the families that need it most."
